

Cycle Director

To ensure the safety of the competitors whilst out on the cycle route. Ensure the correct signage is in place and adequate marshals are in correct place to direct competitors.

Specification:

Awareness of the highway code is crucial here. Good team leader with ability to manage a team over distance.

The Cycle Director is in charge of the layout and safety for all the competitors throughout the cycle section of the Triathlon, as well as the successful de-rig of all signage. The Cycle Director will be responsible for ensuring the marshals are placed in correct positions and they are aware of the duties. The roadside marshals duties are to point competitors in the correct direction and remove signage after the race.

Duties are to ensure:

- Safety of competitors and marshals on the road
- All marshals are wearing hi-vis clothing and are positioned in safe marshal points.
- Check all signage is in correct place and still present for race.
- Ensure last cyclist out is followed from a safe distance, after which signage can begin to be removed.
- On completion of events on the road remove signage and return entire team to Race HQ for children's events.
- A car will be essential for this role

Team:

4 – 20 roadside marshals depending on scale of event.

1-2 First Aid Ambulances depending on size of event

1-2 Bike marshals

Timings;

Cycle Director will need to have completed a check of all the signage prior to race start. All marshals should be in place a minimum of 15 minutes prior to race start. Marshals can begin removing signage after last cyclist has gone past their post.
